## DIVISION SPECIFICATIONS and SHOW RULES

### **\*\* MHJA rated**

#### Hunter Divisions

**\*\*Short Stirrup** Riders 12 years old and younger. No cross entering in Beginner classes, Mini Stirrup, Pony Hunter or with fence height over 2'.

**\*\*Long Stirrup** A Non-Professional rider 13 years old or older. No cross entering in Beginner classes, Mini Stirrup, Pony Hunter or classes with fence height over 2'.

**\*\*Baby Green Hunter** Open to horses & ponies in their first or second year of showing. Fences 2'3" - 2'6". Cannot jump over 2'9" at the show where they compete as a Baby Green Hunter.

**\*\*Pre-Child/Adult Hunter** Open to any Jr. or Amateur on a horse or pony. Fences 2'3" - 2'6". A rider may not compete at the same show in any class where fences exceed 2'9".

**\*\*Pony Hunter** Open to ponies ridden by a junior rider. Age restrictions as specified in USEF Pony Hunter. Fences 2' for small & medium ponies, and 2'6" for large ponies.

**\*\*Modified-Child/Adult Hunter** Open to any Jr. or Amateur on a horse or pony. Fences 2'6" - 2'9". Rider may not cross enter into classes where the fences exceed 3'3".

**\*\*Children's/Adult Amateur Hunter** Open to any Jr. or Amateur on a horse or pony. Fences 2'9" - 3'. **\*\*Jr/Ao Hunter** - Open to horses ridden by a junior or amateur. Amateur or member of amateur family must own the horse being exhibited.

**Open Hunter** Open to all horses, ponies & riders, where not restricted by height.

**Low Hunter** Open to all horses, ponies & riders, where not restricted by height.

**Jumper Classes** - Open to any horse or pony.

**Puddle Jumper** Fences 2'-2'3", meter .60 - .65.

**\*\*Hopeful Jumper** Fences 2'5", meter .70 - .75.

**\*\*Low Schooling Jumper** Fences 2'9" - 2'11", meter .85 - .90.

**\*\*High Schooling Jumper** Fences 3'3" - 3'5", meter 1.00 - 1.05.

**\*\*Child/Adult Amateur Jumper** - Open to any horse or pony ridden by a junior or adult amateur rider. Fences 3'3" - 3'5", meter 1.00 - 1.05.

#### Equitation

**\*\*MHJA Pony Medal** Conducted like the USEF Pony Equitation except 3 riders must complete the course. Tests 1-9, Fences 2' for small & medium ponies. Fences 2'6" large ponies. **Must be member of MHJA.**

**\*\*MHJA Horse Medal** Open to jr and amateur riders. Run like the USEF Hunter Seat Eq. Medal except only 3 riders must complete the course. Tests 1-9. Fences 2'9". **Must be member of MHJA.**

If no MHJA members enter, these will be run as a pony or horse equitation O/F class.

Concessions will be provided on the show grounds.

## Schooling Show Circuit Rules

- All Riders required to wear hard hat & hard-soled shoes when mounted.
- A Beginner is any rider (adult or child) who is in the first three years of showing. Entries will be split by age if needed.
- Very green Hunter is open to green horses who are not able to jump bigger than x-rails. Trot or Canter must declare before riding. Very green Hunter riders may ride a different horse in the main ring.
- X-rails to Verticals – First fence must be trotted, cantering the second fence in the line. Rider has the option to trot or canter the third fence, always cantering the last.
- A Mini Stirrup is any beginning rider. May cross enter into Canter X-rails & X-rails to Verticals.
- Rusty Stirrup Hunter is for mature riders who are coming back to showing after a long absence from the show ring. (Over 18)
- A riders age is determined by the rider's age as of December 1, of the previous year.
- Hunters -Three Horses must complete the course of the first class over fences and compete in the under saddle for points to count.
- Jumpers-Three horses must compete. A horse is considered to have competed when present in the ring when the start signal is given.
- Warm-up – Unlimited schooling rounds can be ridden at the cost of \$15.00 per round. Highest score counts towards ribbons.
- If three horses are not available per division, that division can be combined with a division of same height, or within 3" and pinned accordingly, with points to be given in the appropriate division.
- Equipment – All horses and riders should follow USEF rules for tack and equipment.

Points are awarded to horses &/or riders who participate in 3 or more shows in the series. A Division must fill at 4 shows to receive a Year-End Award.
