#### **DIVISION SPECIFICATIONS and SHOW RULES**

Beginner Cavaletti 4"Four Poles on ground. Riders may cross enter into Trot X-rails & Trot Equitation only. No cross entering into canter classes.

<u>Beginner Trot X- Rails</u> X-rails 18". Riders may cross enter into Canter X-rails, X-rails to Verticals & Beginner Canter Equitation.

Open X-rails to Verticals X-rails/Verticals 18". First fence of a line must be trotted, cantering the second fence in the line.

<u>Beginner Canter X-Rails</u> X-rails 18" -2' Riders may cross enter into X-rails to Verticals, Mini Stirrup & Canter Equitation's only.

Rusty Stirrup Hunter X-rails 18" -2' is for mature riders who are coming back to showing after a long absence from the show ring. (Over 18)

<u>Very green Hunter</u> X-rails 18". Open to green horses.Trot or Canter must declare before riding. Very green Hunter riders may ride a different horse in the main ring. Horse may cross enter into X-rails to Verticals & Equitation on the Flat.

Mini Stirrup X-rails 18" -2' is any beginning rider. May cross enter in to Canter X-rails & X-rails to Verticals. No cross entering into trot divisions.

**Short Stirrup** Riders 12 years old and younger. May cross enter into Open Hunter, Mini-medal and Open Equitation on the Flat 2' only.

<u>Long Stirrup</u> A Non-Professional rider 13 years old or older. No cross entering in Beginner classes, Mini Stirrup, Pony Hunter or classes with fence height over 2'.

<u>Baby Green Hunter</u> Open to horses & ponies in their first or second year of showing. Fences 2'3"- 2'6". Cannot jump over 2'9" at the show where they compete as a Baby Green Hunter.

Pre-Child/Adult Hunter Open to any Jr. or Amateur on a horse or pony.

Fences 2'3" - 2'6". A rider may not compete at the same show in any class where fences exceed 2'9".

<u>Pony Hunter</u> Open to ponies ridden by a junior rider. Age restrictions as specified in USEF Pony Hunter. Fences 2' for small & medium ponies, and 2'6" for large ponies.

Modified-Child/Adult Hunter Open to any Jr. or Amateur on a horse or pony. Fences 2'6"- 2'9". Rider may not cross enter into classes where the fences exceed 3'3".

<u>Ch/Adult/Pro Hunter</u> Open to all horses, ponies & riders. Fences 2'9" - 3'.

<u>Open Hunter</u> Open to all horses, ponies & riders, where not restricted by height.

**Equitation Over Fences** Open all Day height according to current division height.

Mini Medal I Fences 2'/ Mini Medal II Fences 2'6"-2'9" Equitation over fences.

Equitation on Flat I & II No Cross entering between Eq/Flat I & II at the same show.

<u>Low Hunter</u> Open to all horses, ponies & riders, where not restricted by height.

<u>Hunt and Go Derby</u> 2 round derby, with the classic round consisting of 6-8 fences. After completion of the classic round, horses will immediately move to the handy round, consisting of 5-8 fences.

### **Schooling Show Circuit Rules**

- All Riders required to wear hard hat & hard-soled shoes when mounted.
- A Beginner is any rider (adult or child) who is in the first three years of showing. Entries will be split by age if needed.
- A riders age is determined by the rider's age as of December 1, of the previous year.
- Hunters -Three Horses must complete the course of the first class over fences and compete in the under saddle for points to count.
- <u>Jumpers</u>-Three horses must compete. A horse is considered to have competed when present in the ring when the start signal is given.
- Warm-up Time permitting, unlimited schooling rounds can be ridden at the cost of \$20.00 per round. Highest score counts towards ribbons.
- If three horses are not available per division, that division can be combined with a division of same height, or within 3" and pinned accordingly, with points to be given in the appropriate division.
- <u>Equipment</u> All horses and riders should follow USEF rules for tack and equipment.
